### **COMMITTEE REPORTS**

- **Hitmakers**
  - Bought 4000 flyers and have distributed over 2000 so far!
  - \$100 Tickets get a pre-show dinner at The Lighthouse
  - Show is at the Indian Lake High School and it is air conditioned!
  - Saturday, July 23, 2022!
- **Membership**
  - Still doing 4<sup>th</sup> Thursday Food Trucks, got 7 memberships last time

- **SOL – Save Our Lake**
  - Shoreline Construction will be talking about their equipment and activities
  - NEBO Global will be tracking the ILWP harvesters
  - The ODNR funds to run the harvesters will run out by July 11, 2022
  - Brenda Crabtree has been doing individual testing (not sanctioned by the ILWP) on the sediment of the lake

## **OLD BUSINESS**

- House Bill 377 allocated \$750,000 for Indian Lake

## **NEW BUSINESS**

- Ed talked about sampling method and discussed his plan on identifying weed species and density
- Gov. DeWine went out for a tour of the lake
- Increased communication from ODNR
- Total of 7 harvesters are out on the Lake
- Dredging could be part of a long-term solution, but it will be very costly
- ODNR will be putting out literature describing the weeds and solutions
- Shoreline Construction has converted a trash skimmer out of DC to a weed harvester to go along with their Big Rake!
  - Pulled out 1,530 yards of material so far!
  - 58 cu/yd per hour
